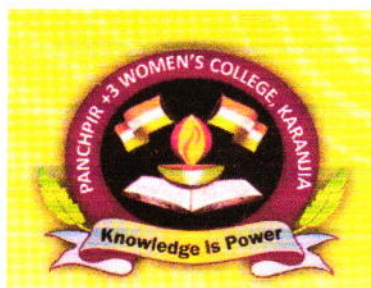

Panchpir +3 Women's College Encapsuled:

The college was established in 1996 by the dynamic efforts of a few generous social workers, administrative officers, educationalists and intellectuals of the area. Establishing and running of a women's college in a tribal-dominated educationally backward area has been a great challenge for everybody- from the pioneers to the teachers of the college. The Institution moved on a shaky and tedious path, taking only 58 number of students in its initial stage.

Gradually the institution flourished from a tiny bud to a complete flower, blossoming with all its colour, grace and fragrance. It got permanent Recognition and Concurrence from the Govt. of Odisha and permanent affiliation from the North Orissa University. In the year 2009, it spread further after getting Honours in two subjects. In the same year, a branch of computer Education was added to enable our students to become skillful in computer fields.

Meanwhile the college was included in the U.G.C. by acquiring 2(F) and 12(B) from 2013. It has also been one of the Resource centre for on-line admission functioning under SRC, Govt. of odisha.

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) was established on 27th June, 2013. It followed all the details of the guidelines under XII Plan. The major objectives of the IQAC are development of qualitative education; organization of inter and intra institutional seminars, debates, discussions and workshops; and facilitation of a learner-centric environment.
